

Jane Hanna / Marcham Parish Council Consultation results

about the Taylor Wimpey / Anson Trust planning application

Taylor Wimpey, on behalf of the Anson Trust, submitted in April 2012 a planning application to build 51 houses on half of the existing Anson Field and to build a new Village Community Centre on the land behind Longfields / Hyde Copse.

Marcham Parish Council and Jane Hanna sent out a questionnaire to every person aged 16 and over in the village, asking whether or not they were in favour of the application.

We hereby confirm that the votes cast were as follows:

Yes votes (in favour of the application)	359	(46.6%)
No votes (against the application)	412	(53.4%)
Returns without a vote	13	

The response rate was as follows:

Marcham village: **62%** (329 Yes, 393 No - out of 1160 residents)

Marcham parish outside the village: **28%** (30 Yes, 19 No - out of 178 residents)
